The Canadian Climate Change Capacity Development Fund (CCCDF)

- Close to final approval for the project: “*Adapting to Climate Change in the Caribbean Region*” at C\$3.14 to run from Sept. 2001 to Feb. 2004.
- Assuming CIDA Ministerial approval, detailed planning will go forward and contract components developed. Target date for signing CIDA contract is Aug 31/01. CCCDF requires Canadian proponents/contract with Canadian organization.

Adapting to Climate Change in the Caribbean Region

Consists of 9 components:

- ***Project 1:*** Detailed Project Design and Business Plan for Regional Climate Change Centre (\$125,000)
- ***Project 2:*** Public Education and Outreach (PEO) (\$420,000)
- ***Project 3:*** Integrating Climate Change into a Physical Planning Process using a Risk Management Approach (\$480,000)

CPACC

- ***Project 4:*** Strengthening Technical Capacity (\$1,040,000) – through CIMH and National institutes, supporting Masters level course at UWI, development of region-specific climate change scenarios and liaison with other SIDS (in Caribbean and Pacific)
- ***Project 5:*** Integrating Adaptation Planning in Environmental Assessments for National and Regional Development Projects (\$250,000)
- ***Project 6:*** Implementation Strategies for Adaptation in the Water Sector (\$130,000)
- ***Project 7:*** Formulation of Adaptation Strategies to Protect Human Health (\$260,000)

- ***Project 8:*** Adaptation Strategies for Agriculture and Food (\$130,000)
- ***Project 9:*** Fostering Collaboration/Cooperation with non-CARICOM Countries (\$100,000)

- ***Sub-total*** C\$2,935,000

- **Plus** Administration and Management at 7% (\$205,450)

- **Total** **C\$3,140,450**
