- **(i) identify and implement appropriate technical and institutional response mechanisms for adaptation to global climate change;**
- **(ii) support and promote further research on climate change monitoring and sectoral vulnerability and risk assessment;**
- **(iii) prepare the region for optimal participation in the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM); and**
- **(iv) assist countries in mainstreaming climate variability and change considerations into development planning and sectoral investment projects.**

Mainstream adaptation to climate change in national development planning and public and private investment decisions.
