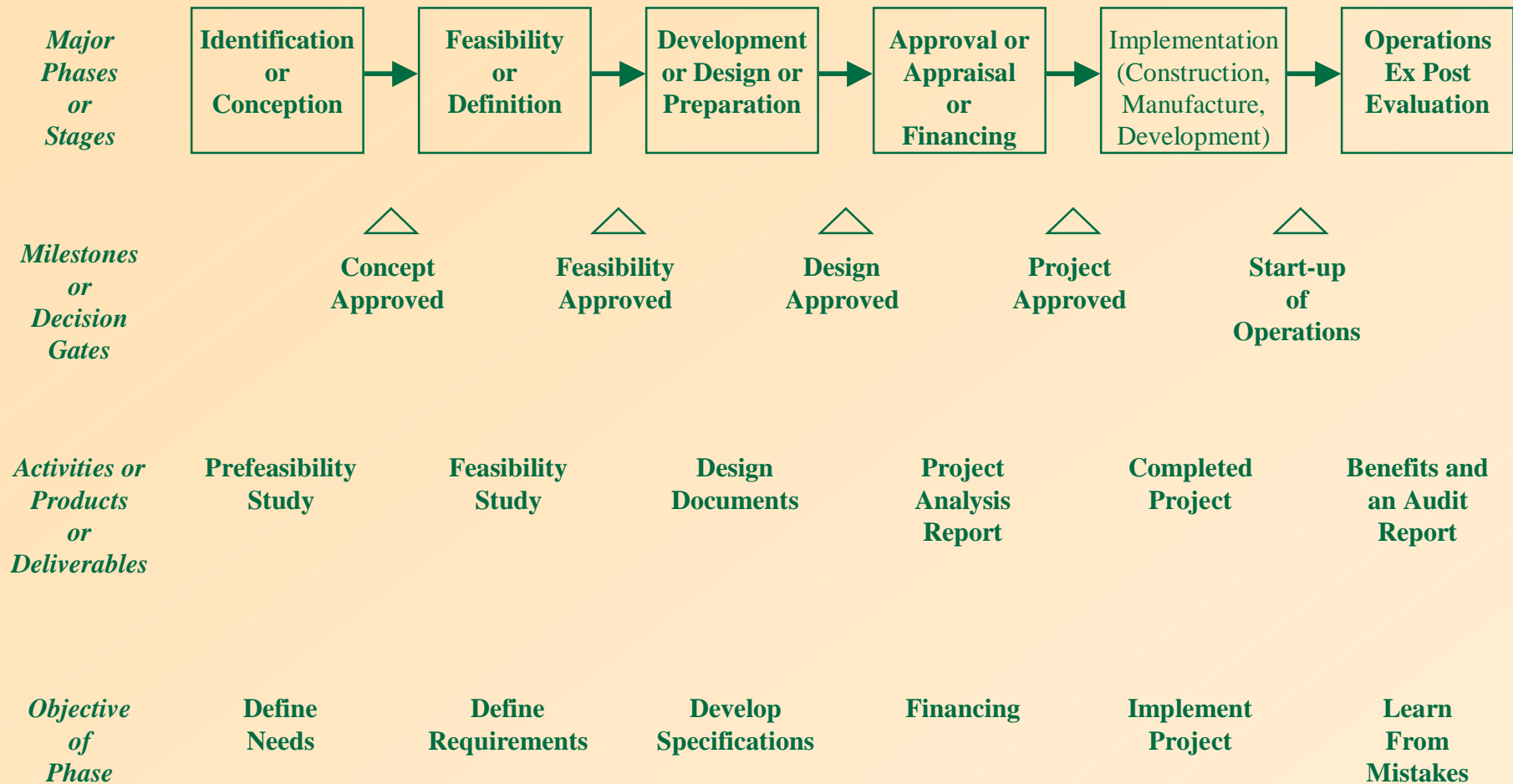

# Six Types of Feasibility

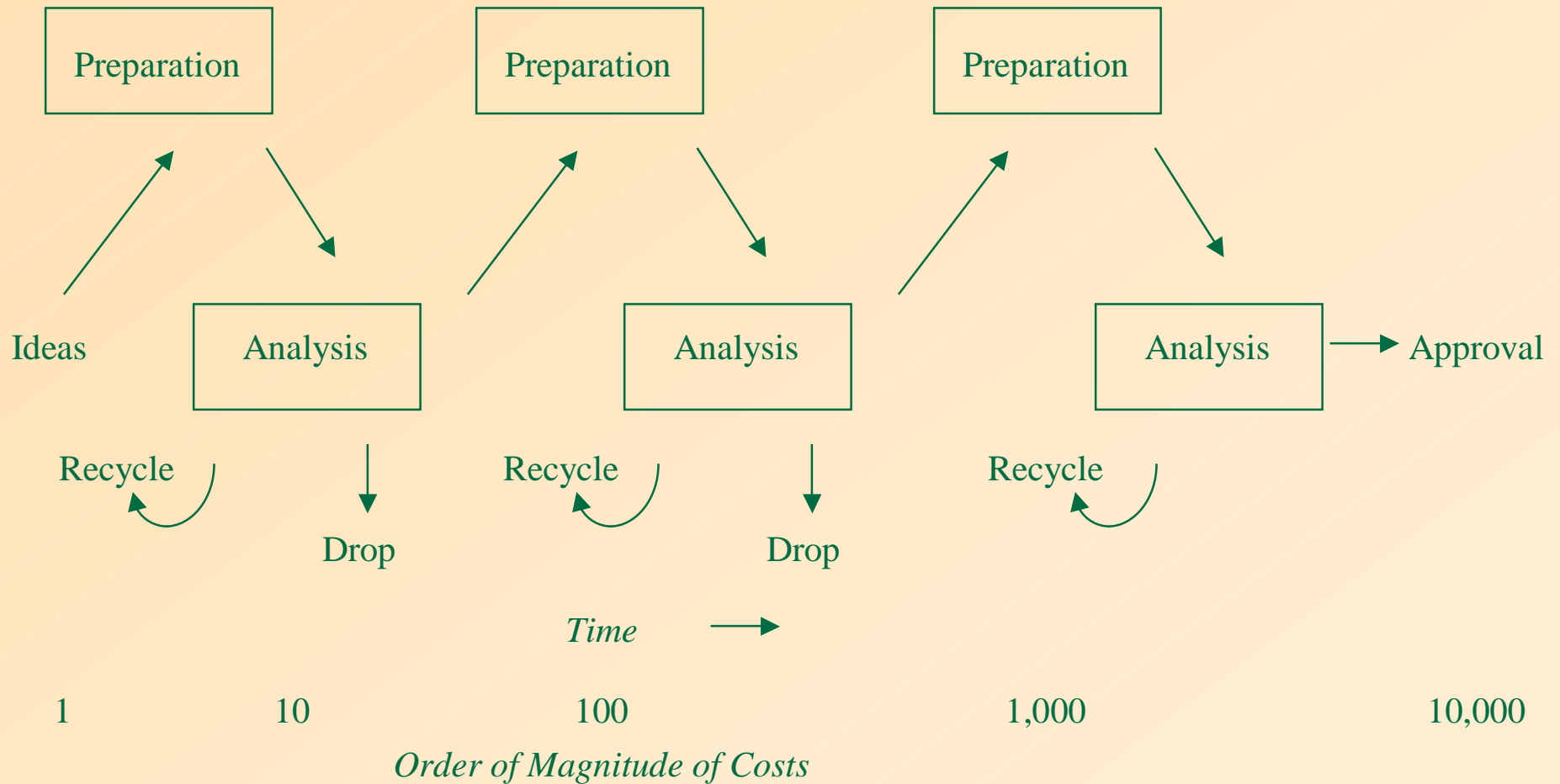
- **Technical—Can it be done?**
- **Economic—Is the benefit/cost ratio for the country acceptable?**
- **Institutional—Can the organization maintain it?**
- **Environmental—How will it affect the environment?**
- **Social—How will it impact society?**

# Hierarchy of Objectives (Logical Framework)

- **Clarify need**
- **Clarify requirements**
- **Communicate project objectives**
- **Get input and feedback**
- **Helps expost evaluators measure “right” objectives**
- **Makes relationship of objectives clear**
